

MINUTES OF 1/7/09 SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
135 East Johnson Avenue, Chelan, Washington

PRESENT: Mayor Goedde; Councilmembers Cooney, Greenfield, Harper, Morehouse, Pape-Miller; Administrator Reinbold; Clerk Liles; Parks & Recreation Director Sablan; Public Works Director Van Epps. **EXCUSED ABSENCE:** Councilmember Morse. (Council position #1 vacant.)

At 7:00 p.m., Mayor Goedde called to order this special City Council meeting to continue discussion regarding the design and location of Section J of the Lakeside Trail.

Reinbold reported that several concerned citizens had asked for further discussion on the proposed trail segment. Reinbold also noted that a number of citizens responded to information and a request for input posted on the City's website, but the consultants were not able to access those responses.

Explaining the purpose of the meeting, Sablan said that Perry Shea could not attend the December 11, 2008, Council meeting to assist Steve Worthy in presenting the consultants' recommendations for the design and location of Section J of the trail. Council had therefore postponed any decision on accepting those recommendations until Shea could be present to answer questions. Sablan pointed out that both Worthy and Shea were present at this meeting.

Shea then presented his recommendation for locating the trail along Lake Street and Terrace Avenue (Option #1), explaining why that is the preferred route and why the recommendation includes restricting traffic on those two streets to one way.

Shea, Worthy, Sablan and VanEpps responded first to audience comments and questions concerning the proposed trail segment's location, design and impact on the neighborhood, and then to Council comments and questions concerning project costs and the possible use of city employees and volunteer labor to minimize costs.

Meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
